SUBJ: Permission to open Private High Schools in
the State during the year 1968-69.

INFO: Proposals received from the Deputy Directors of
Public Instruction on the subject.

2. Govt. Order No. AD 30 501 of dated 1-6-68.

ORDERED THAT:-

The list of High Schools permitted to be started during the
year 1968-69 is herewith appended.

Permission is granted to start the new High Schools subject
to " fulfilment of the conditions. Unless the conditions are
met with, the school may not be considered either for recogni-
tion or for aid.

CONDITIONS

1. The first instalment of stability fund of Rs. 500/-/-
deposited in the joint name of the President/Chairman of the Society/
and the Director of Public Instruction in Mysore, Bangalore in the
Post Office Savings Bank Account/Scheduled Bank before starting the
school. The Savings Bank Account Number with name of the Post
Office/Scheduled Bank should be communicated to the Deputy Directors
of Public Instruction, the District Educational Officer/Educational
Inspector and also in this office.

2. The management should be got registered, if not already
done so, before starting the school. The registration Number and
date along with an attested copy of the same should be forwarded to
the Deputy Directors of Public Instruction, the District Educational
Officer/Educational Inspector and this office.

3. A trained graduate with not less than 5 years of teaching
experience shall be appointed as Headmaster. If such a Head Master
is not available, the school should not be started.

4. Since it is not desirable to have un-economical schools,
there should be two Sections in Standard VIII to start with and
the strength of the two Sections together shall not be less than 70.

5. No maintenance grant will be paid for the first 3 years
except Token ad hoc grant in the form of fee compensation at the
Standard Rates of Tuition fees prescribed in the Grant-in-aid
Code and calculated on the basis of average attendance of pupils
of Standard VIII during the year, provided that the management
take steps to credit the entire amount of fee collection during
the year as detailed under rule 29(a) of the amendments to Grant-
in-aid Code, into the Treasury to the Head of Account "XXII-
Education-P-General-J-Miscellaneous".

In the case of Girls' High Schools, they will be eligible
for maintenance grant (including advance Salary grant) from the
date of starting, provided that all the conditions (including
the condition of having 70 Strength) prescribed in this memo have
actually fulfilled.

6. Adequate and satisfactory arrangements for accommoda-

shall be made for Class rooms, the Office, the Staff room and a waiting room for Girl Students if any, along with the necessary sanitary arrangements and the Play ground. Arrangements to provide adequate furniture, Laboratory equipment, teaching aids, books, etc., are made as per rule 8 (a) of the amendments to Grant-in-aid Code.

7. Compliance of all the rules laid down in the Grant-in-aid Code regarding accommodation, Staff, rates of fees, admission etc., should be reported to the Deputy Director of Public Instruction, the District Educational Officer/Educational Inspector and this office.

8. The management shall apply for recognition in the prescribed form to the concerned District Educational Officer/Educational Inspector within two months from the date of opening of the high school.

9. The managements should open the school with Standard VIII only for which permission is granted and if in any case, it is found that they have started the school with Standards VIII and IX, permission granted for the opening of the school will automatically stand withdrawn.

10. The date of opening of the school should be communicated by Post to the Deputy Director of Public In-
struction, the District Educa-
tional Officer/Educational Inspector and this office within a week from the date of the opening of the High School, but not later than the 30th June '68 in any case. If the intimation for having opened the school is not received in time, the question of granting temporary recognition and taken aid/Salary grant will not be considered at all.

11. In the case of Local Body High Schools, concurrence of Government in DEPO/RMO/Department as the case may be, is necessary before the actual starting of the High School and without such concurrence, the school will not be considered either for recognition or for aid.
